2222a. The chairman reported that he had been assured by Mr Glyn Shaw, highways, that the speed signs would be erected on Wall Bank very shortly.

2222b. Councillor Mrs S Madeley reported that she had been taking some advice about the structure of the footbridge on the footpath in Rushbury and would be able to give more details when she had received a report.

2223. PLACE PLAN.

Councillor C Stevenson had been doing some research and had discovered that the records held by Shropshire Council on residences in the parish of Rushbury were not accurate. He agreed to draw up a chart and the clerk would complete it from the electoral roll.

Councillors discussed the facilities available in the parish and decided to submit the following items as priority for this year .

- Sewage connectivity for East wall, and parts of Longville ,
- safer pedestrian walkways in Rushbury Road,
- better visibility at East wall cross roads ,

- **fast fibre broadband availability in the whole of the parish ,**
- **improved mobile phone reception .**
