

Openreach - Temporary Road Closure - Grandshore Lane, Frittenden - 7th September 2026 (Tunbridge Wells District)

Due to works planned to be undertaken by **Openreach**, it will be necessary to close part of Grandshore Lane, Frittenden, from 7th September 2026 with estimated completion by 8th September 2026.

Grandshore Lane, Frittenden, will be closed in the vicinity of Grandshore Oaks. To the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

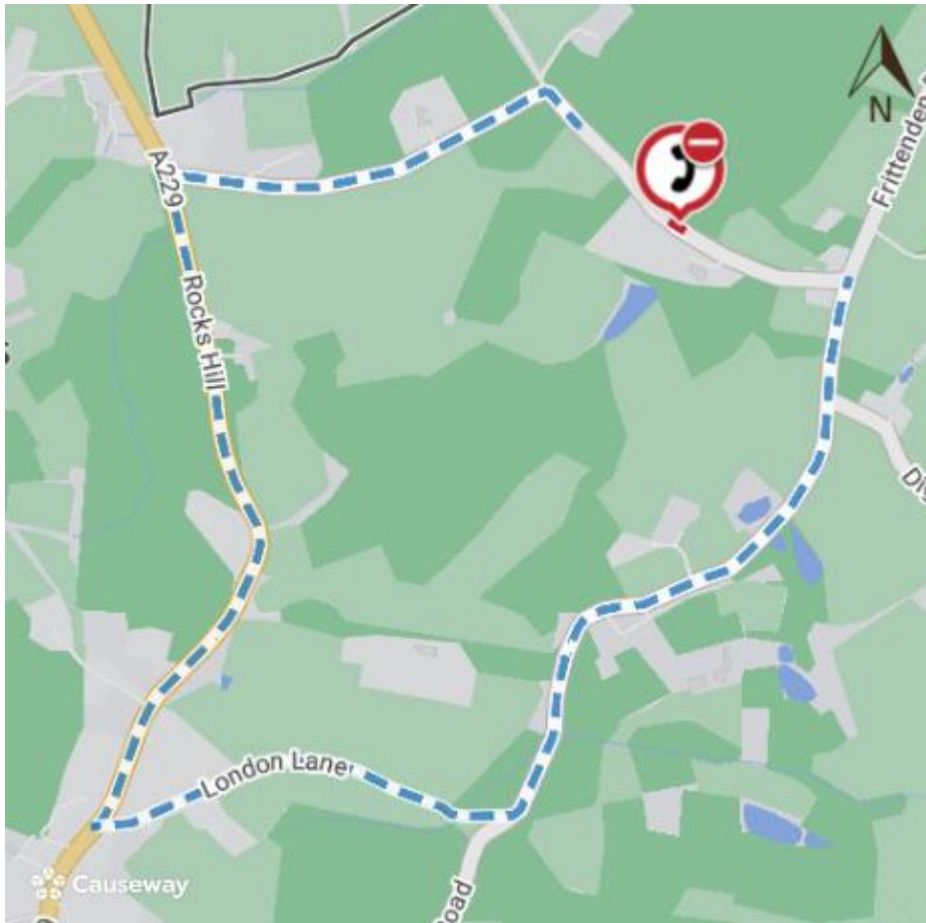
The alternative route for any through traffic is via Grandshore Lane, A229 Rocks Hill, A229 Camden Hill, London Lane, Frittenden Road, Cranbrook Road, Grandshore Lane and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce to allow telegraph pole replacement and associated cable rehanging works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Openreach.
