Comment	<p>We support this policy in principle but note that the South Downs Tranquillity Study does not appear to be in the public domain. The map (Fig 5.3) shows an isolated area with negative tranquillity score in the Warnford/ West Meon area which may be a result of noise from irresponsible and illegal motorcycle use on the A32. If this is the case we do not believe that it is reasonable for future</p>

development to be based on these figures. We request access to the South Downs Tranquillity Study so that we can properly consider this point and decide whether the evidence base for the policy is sound in terms of its implications for Warnford.

What improvements or changes do you suggest?

Put the South Downs Tranquillity Study in the public domain so that the evidence base can be examined and the impact on specific locations assessed.
