Community Submissions

Several parishioners were very concerned about the high volume of HGV's travelling through Parish Lane/Collum Green Lane. TB has passed on the information to Bucks Council, also TVP as there is a risk to pedestrians as there is no footway in parts. Residents asked if it was possible to have a sign saying (No HGV's) or long term width restrictions. TB said this will be raised through HPC to BC.

HPC will be putting up the MVAS outside Top Farm.

Tom Webb asked for a breakdown of Grant Randall's contract and especially what was due in the Church Yard.

Repainting posts round pond. Clerk to get quote before March.

Clear path behind pond – If the pond is going to be cleared, the contractors will be drawing off the water and depositing in Church Meadow, so the path will not be used then. NC checked and said there is no 'official' pathway there.
