## A2 Bean and Ebbsfleet junction improvements – excavation and piling works

Dear local residents and businesses

As part of the on-going works on the A2, we will be carrying out a number of work activities overnight, including saw cutting and breaking out to accommodate the new concrete barrier, followed by piling works for the new foundations at Bean Bridge. The works will require a mixture of full closures and lane closures overnight. When full closures are in place, a clearly signed diversion will be in place. The work will take place east of the Bean junction on the A2 mainline carriageway.

The work will take place between 8pm and 6am from Monday 27 July for three weeks. This will inevitably create some noise for those who live close to the works, but we will do our best to minimise this wherever possible.

We will then be able to remove the existing gantry at Bean junction which will take place overnight on Saturday 8 August. Due to the nature of the work, a full closure will be required in both directions. A fully signed diversion route will be in place. The work is planned to take place overnight, between 8pm and 8am.
