	A representative from Your Leisure gave an overview of	
	the challenges being faced by TDC and Your Leisure on	
	the beaches and promenades of Westgate. Your	
	Leisure would like to explore working in collaboration	
	and trying to resolve issues that arise each year.

	Cllr Page reported an update to Members from Your	
	Leisure on the recent dialogue concerning cycling on the	
	promenade. It was highlighted that there are mixed	
	messages and the signage, byelaws and bay inspectors	
	are all in need of more coordination. It was agreed that

	most efficient way to slow cyclists on the promenade.

	debated and agreed the reasons for Q7a which the Town Clerk would use to complete the online public consultation that KCC have provided for the proposed signal-controlled pedestrian crossing on Canterbury Road, Westgate on Sea.

There has also been concern raised by a resident in relation to the number of trees discussed in a report by a biodiversity officer which do not appear to agree number of trees on the planning application.
