HOLMESDALE ROAD, SOUTH DARENTH

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Holmesdale Road, South Darenth will be closed to through traffic, on or after 26th October 2020 for up to 2 days.

The road will be closed at the sharp bend where Holmesdale Road and Holmesdale Hill meet.

The alternative route is via Holmesdale Road, East Hill, Paddock Close, Holmesdale Hill.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway patching to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
