Wolds Ward Barnoldby-le-Beck Update January 2017

Crime

There have been 64 crimes reported across the whole of the Wolds Ward from 1st November to 31st December. Of these there have been four reports in Barnoldby-le-Beck.

Sometime during the early hours of 7th November, a garage at a property on Waltham Road was broken into. A red & black Lapierre mtb and an orange Orange Clockwork mtb were stolen.

About 2am on 8th November, a car parked on the driveway in front of a garage at a property in the village was moved by physical force. The garage was entered and another car inside was driven out the garage. The occupants disturbed the intruders who left the area on foot without stealing anything.

Sometime between 7th & 10th November, an insecure garage on Bradley road was entered. A grey & white Carrere mtb was stolen.

Overnight 15th & 16th November a shed at a property on Church Lane was entered. A red Gear mtb was stolen.

There have been no reports in December.

There has been no reports of ASB.
