- 4. Heaviest Marrow
- 5. Decorated Pumpkin, Marrow or Squash
- 6. Carved Pumpkin, Marrow or Squash
- 7. Decorated or Carved Pumpkin, Marrow or Squash, Junior (child under 15)
- **8. Best Squash** (other than a pumpkin or marrow)

Exhibitors rules:

- 1. There will be no charge for entries and no monetary prizes given.
- 2. Entries must be sent by email to dhstreasurer@outlook.com by Wednesday 21st October. Please state your Name, Address, Telephone number, the Classes you are entering and for the Junior classes state Age. Entries cannot be accepted on the day.
- 3. Please deliver your exhibits between 9 and 10am on the day. Your entry cards will be ready to collect and a steward will indicate where to place your exhibit and card. Please leave the area promptly once you have placed your exhibit.
- 4. A steward will supervise the weighing and record weights for Classes 1 to 4 but you will need to place your own Pumpkin on the scales. If it is too heavy for one person you must bring family members from your own household bubble to assist.
- 5. Please collect your exhibits promptly at the end of the show (1pm) and continue to maintain social distancing.
