(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER FEBRUARY 2024**

Southern Water works.

To allow new connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Halstow Lane, Lower Halstow.

A closure is planned from 8th February 2024, with estimated completion by 12th February 2024, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ002SWAT13084644-01 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Halstow Lane will be closed in the vicinity of Chapel House, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while new connection works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Halstow Lane, Forge Lane, The Street, Horsham Lane, Otterham Quay Lane, Lower Rainham Road, A2 Moor Street, London Road, Hartlip Hill, Breach Lane and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
