PLANNING COMMITTEE MEETINGS AND APPLICATIONS

Planning applications are shown on the Tunbridge Wells Borough Council website and the Parish Council is having its monthly Planning Committee. Applications have increased recently. Residents are invited to attend these remote meetings by contacting the Clerk as above.

If you do not want to attend the meetings, you are able to make comments on applications via the TWBC site which are important to ensure your views are shared with the Borough Council.

NEW PCSO

Our area has a new Police Community Support Officer ("PCSO"). His name is Nicholas Brown and he can be contacted, currently by email only, on:

Nicholas.Brown@kent.police.uk. The role of a PCSO is to work with communities and businesses to promote community safety, along with identifying and supporting vulnerable people in the community. The PCSO will spend time in specific areas and will respond to concerns raised.

However, you should phone 999 or 101 if you experience problems in the village which need urgent help.

PARISH OFFICE

The Clerk and Assistant Clerk are working in the office with appropriate safeguards. If visitors do need to go to the office, they will be seen under the most up-to-date Government guidelines and restrictions. Feel free to email or call the office where messages can be left but please note visitors will not be allowed into the office.

SEPTEMBER HORSE FAIR CANCELLED

Along with many other horse fairs in the country this year, the Travellers community has made the difficult but carefully considered decision to cancel the traditional horse fair which usually takes place in the village. The pandemic has affected many of their activities and the Parish Council appreciates and supports this decision which will help protect their community as well as residents and visitors around the parish.
