A1/21 **ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN** –Not required as Chairman of Parish Council present.

A2/21 **APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE** – County Cllr. Bastiman (prior commitment).

A3/21 **Noted** no parish assembly was held in 2020 due to the Coronavirus pandemic and the subsequent restrictions on travel and public meetings.

A4/21 **MINUTES**

Having been previously circulated, the minutes of the Annual Assembly of 7th May 2019, having been confirmed as accurate at a Parish Council meeting held on 4th June 2019, Minute 39/19 refers, were **approved**.

A5/21 **PUBLIC OPEN FORUM** No matters raised.

A6/21 **ANNUAL REPORT BY CHAIRMAN OF PARISH COUNCIL** – Cllr. Hill reported that the Coronavirus pandemic had had a large impact, especially for the front-line workers living in the parish. It had also meant that the Parish Council had been meeting virtually (using the website 'zoom') as it had not been possible to have face to face meetings. The number of planning applications had increased. A new grass cutting contractor had been appointed for the year beginning 1st April 2021. The Parish Council has recently installed Vehicle Activated Speed signs in the village, though it was too soon to tell how effective they were.
