

The ruins of Calder Abbey will shortly come under the auctioneer's hammer as part of the Calder Abbey Estate, which is to be sold on July 17.

Calder Abbey Estate, at Calderbridge, will be auctioned next Wednesday. Comprising the ruins of the 800-year-old Calder Abbey, a mansion house, valuable fishing, several farms, cottages in Calderbridge village, growing timber and woodlands,

this well-known country estate (with freehold) extends to 1,467 acres and produces an annual rent of £3,420. The sale, ordered by the trustees of T. H. Rymer, deceased, will take place at Calderbridge Village Hall.
