#### THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLES

8 thefts from vehicles parked in the New Forest Heart area in June. Knightwood Oak, Ivy Wood, Bramshaw Wood, Longslade View and Fritham were the New Forest car parks targeted while another vehicle was broken into overnight at the Travelodge at Stoney Cross, and another while it was parked at the Careys Manor Hotel in Brockenhurst.

Patrols of the local beauty spot car parks by the New Forest Police Cadets and the Police volunteers has seen the number of thefts drop by almost 40 percent in the last 12 months and almost 30 percent in the last three years. Advice:-

- When leaving your car, close all windows and lock your car.
- When parking at home, use your garage. If you don't have a garage, park in a well-lit area.
- Don't leave anything on display in your vehicle.
- Take all your personal possessions with you.
- Remove sat nav holders and visible sat nav ring marks from windscreens (if possible).
- Leave the glove box open to show there's nothing inside.
- Fit an alarm or immobiliser to your car.

Just after 4 o'clock on the morning of Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> June, 4 men armed with knives threatened the cashier on duty and stolen cash and cigarettes.
