1.1 Employment Support Service



The West Northamptonshire Employment Support Service, delivered by WNC's Economy team, is a free service which is available to every resident and employer in West Northamptonshire.

The wide range of services include support with job-searching, interview tips & tricks, help with CVs and support with confidence, mental health and wellbeing. Plus, much more.

To promote this free employment support, banners and flyers are now displayed in all West Northamptonshire libraries - Brackley, Brixworth, Daventry, Deanshanger, Duston, Hunsbury, Northamptonshire Central, Towcester, Weston Favell as well as in the community libraries in

Abington, Long Bucky, Middleton Cheney, Moulton, Roade, Woodford Halse and Woodford. To further raise awareness of this essential service, the Economy team is running a 6-week digital campaign on the Chronicle & Echo website which is estimated to be seen by over 100,000 residents.

The free Employment Support service is supported by expert partners, who possess a wide range of experience knowledge support and to employment needs. The Economy team continue to grow the service, its capabilities and the number of partners involved. There are no eligibility criteria. no formal paperwork or hurdles to overcome - it's a free & accessible service for everyone to use.

The Economy team can work with residents to access the support and training needed to find sustainable local employment and enable every employer to utilise the skilled local workforce to grow their business.
