## Bowls England National Competitions 2020 Terms & Conditions (Inter-Club Events)

By submitting an entry the competitor agrees to adhere to Bowls England's Terms and Conditions as outlined below:

1. Each event is open to all affiliated clubs/members of Bowls England (Entry requirements for each event are included within the Bowls England Regulations).
2. All entries will require the full payment of the entry fee at time of entry.
3. All fields marked mandatory on the entry forms must be filled out completely, with direct contact details given for the named entrant.
4. No entries will be permitted following the close of entries on 1st February 2020, unless approved by Bowls England.
5. The email address given during the entry process will be the main point of contact with Bowls England. The supplied email address will receive all correspondence from Bowls England, and will be used by the entrant to access their online account.
6. Bowls England will use the contact details provided on this form for the organisation of National Competitions in 2020. This includes sharing of contact information with relevant parties to arrange fixtures, in accordance with the 'legitimate interest' principle of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). 7. All competitors must adhere to the Rules and Regulations and Code of Conduct of Bowls England at all times. (Details of which can be found on the Bowls England website).

### 8. Inter-Club Events

Players are required to play from the club in which they play their National Championships. Players entering National Championships in another country are not eligible to participate. In any year a competitor selected to play in Inter-Club Competitions may only represent one club should they belong to more than one club.

#### (a) Men's Top Club

A club side shall consist of 11 players. The disciplines are Two-Wood Singles (21 ends), Four-Wood Singles (21 shots), Four-Wood Pairs (21 ends), Three-Wood Triples (18 ends) and Two-Wood Fours (21 ends).

#### (b) Women's Top Club

A club side shall consist of 10 players. The disciplines are Four-Wood Singles (21 shots), Four-Wood Pairs (21 ends), Three-Wood Triples (18 ends) and Two-Wood Fours (21 ends).

#### (c) Men's Club Two Fours

A club side shall consist of two rinks of four players and they shall play 21 ends, two bowls each player.

#### (d) Tony Allcock Trophy

(i) All players shall be aged 60 years or over on 1st April in the year of the competition.

(ii) A club side shall consist of two rinks of four players from its membership in accordance with the National Competition regulations (two men and two women per rink) and they shall play 18 ends, two bowls each player.
