

Neighbourhood Plan Update – February 2021

I am delighted to report that we have a draft Neighbourhood Plan for Longframlington! We have listened to all of the comments, suggestions, and consultation responses received over the last 18 months and are confident that the Plan reflects the collective wishes of the residents who live in the Parish.

We now have to carry out an eight-week period of consultation, to give you all a chance to view the draft Plan, and to make any comments that you might have. This is a statutory consultation period, required by law. **If you have any comments or feedback on the Plan, you need to respond between 1st March 2021 and 25th April 2021.** Details of how to respond, and contact details for Garth (Parish Clerk) are listed below.
