BIRCHINGTON**

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow works to be carried out to clear blockages in underground telecoms cabling, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Manor Road, St Nicholas at Wade, Birchington, in the Thanet area.

Daytime closures are planned from Monday 23 November 2020 for up to 3 days, between 08:00 hours and 18:00 hours each day.

Manor Road will be closed at its northern end, in the general vicinity of the junction with The Length, to the actual extent indicated on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A28 Canterbury Road and The Length.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation, and updated information can be found on www.one.network – [BT Openreach Permit BC417SE0000000103407ONSA], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
