- 2. To arrange the setting up of a separate Management Committee as their Agents to undertake all aspects of management of leased property No.2 for the benefit of West Ilsley and of the Residents of West Ilsley.**
- 3. Following the setting up of the new Management Committee as above, to agree with both Agents, appropriate Constitutions embracing all aspects of their Operating Terms and Conditions, and Accountability to the Parish Council.**
