NOTICEBOARDS POLICY

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidelines for the usage of the noticeboards owned by Greenhead Parish (sited on the village hall wall and at Bankfoot) and the material which can be displayed.

The notice boards are to be used for the posting of official council notices and community information which includes:

- Election notices and results
- Parish Council meetings agendas
- Parish Councillor details
- Other notices – the boards can be used to advertise charitable and non-profit making events and activities of interest to the residents of Greenhead. Events outside the parish can only be displayed at the discretion of the council. (Contact the clerk)
- Notices not allowed include:
 - No larger than A4 size
 - Political leaflets
 - Commercial business information.
- The council will remove older and out of date notices.
- In the event there is insufficient room for council notices, the council reserve the right to remove non council posters.
