- 1. OSG PC Comms:
 - a. Website review in light of PC Clerk recent email. Attendees agreed proposal makes sense and is fit for purpose. **ACTIONS:**
 - i. NB to request that CH be granted access to help manage all non-PC pages on the website.
 - ii. PCs in the pub advertise intent with website and seek any technical support for when or if
 - iii. Need to upload all previous Dragon comms to the website CH can do once granted access.
 - b. Facebook: seems to be running well and as intended.
 - i. OSG Community Gp Page is archived and only accessible by those who were already members of it but it is no longer in use.

- ii. OSG Group Page open to the public and active.
- c. Dragon excellent work under CH, really useful medium for PC comms and working very well.
- d. PC Clerk comms **ACTION** NB to confirm with Clerk what comms she can and cannot do and through which mediums.
- e. A346 concerns Should we consider 'joining hands' with OSA PC and writing to Wiltshire Council over joint parish concerns. We should say something about it as it does impact both villages in many ways:
 - i. Accidents becoming more regular
 - ii. Poor unkept signage
 - iii. Road markings/painting
 - iv. Warning signs for bends chevrons etc.
 - v. Do not overtake signs etc.

2. Proposal of 'PCs in the Pub'

- a. Need to secure a date and advertise said date proposing 29th March (will need to send out a separate flier for this, Facebook, WhatsApp and website notifications) or either the 12th or 19th April also using The Dragon to communicate. Inn with the Well happy to accommodate just need to confirm date well in advance with them.

 - iii. Sunday 7th May OSG School has an event on circa 12-1600hrs could do picnic on the green again after that event, with bar, baking competition etc. as likely several villagers will be around given the school event? NB to liaise with Community Initiatives WG.
