July 2018 Update

The recent Neighbourhood Planning event on 19 June 2018 was attended by 33 residents.

Feedback from this event was very positive. The event was reported as very successful in producing the material for a vision for our villages for the next 20 years or so.

The outcomes of this event will be shared initially at the next Steering Group meeting scheduled for **Wednesday 18 July at Morton Church Hall, 7.30-9.30pm.**

All residents are invited to this meeting if they are particularly interested in shaping our Neighbourhood Plan. Please let us know if you are going to attend.

Since this process began in July 2017 a total of 104 individual residents have expressed their support for creating a Neighbourhood Plan. This is either through attendance at one of the events, the Steering Group or in response to the questionnaire circulated to all households in March 2018.

We are now reaching a critical stage of the process where what is produced is highly likely to be included in the final draft of the Neighbourhood Plan.

It is therefore very important that all residents know what is being signed up to on behalf of the two villages.

We will be making available copies of the working drafts of the Draft Vision and Character Profile in due course and we will write out to residents after the Steering Group meeting. This will most likely be in September 2018 after the summer holidays.
