Of all the parishes of Thanet, Manston is uniquely placed as it links all the main towns of Thanet meaning that, as traffic congestion increases, hundreds more vehicles will add to the vehicle volume using totally unsuitable rat runs of Manston Parish. Southern Water, with a string of apologies, continues to pollute our beaches due to its lack of investment and a failure to upgrade Its infrastructure and resilience to deal with the increase population and occasional storm surges. Bearing in mind that Thanet relies heavily on its tourist trade, and a toxic label that its, albeit, attractive golden beaches are unclean can easily destroy that trade. We have a shortage of GPs and surgeries. Schools are under enormous pressure with oversized classes. Precious farmland is being lost to these new building sites instead of targeting brownfield sites.

		This is at a time when UK food security and concern about the pollution that air miles adds to food imported from abroad, should inspire a drive to grow more of our own food.
		There are already a number of new build sites nearing completion and, when occupied, will add to the problems already listed. Until these issues are addressed, there should be no further house building. Its not a valid argument that Thanet has a housing waiting list of about 1800. Despite all the new housing in the area in recent years, it has hardly reduced the waiting list.
