Carnival Grants

Every year, Bishopstoke holds a Carnival and this year it is on the weekend of the 10th and 11th September.

What people may not know is how Carnival grants work. Each year, the money that is collected during the parade goes into the Carnival Street Collection fund, and each year we are required to give it all out to local groups and community activities as grants.

Recent examples of groups receiving grants have been the Scouts, Age Concern and ARK Eastleigh, but most local groups can apply. If you are a local community group and have a need, or a project, that could benefit from a grant in the region of £50 to £150 pounds, then the Carnival Street Collection fund may be able to help.
