

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VARIOUS ROADS, DORCHESTER/WEYMOUTH FOR HARDY HALF MARATHON 2024

DORSET COUNCIL has issued an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit the use of the following roads by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except those taking part in the event and emergency vehicles, to facilitate a public event on the highway.

On Sunday 12 May 2024 between 09:30 and 13:30 or as otherwise indicated by signs on site.

The effect of this Order is as follows:

- [1] To impose temporary road closure on B3159 Martinstown between Martinstown Village Stores and its junction with the access road to Turnpike House.
- [2] To impose temporary road closure on Blackdown Road from Hardy Monument access for approximately 385metres in an easterly direction.
- [3] To impose temporary road closure on B3159 Goulds Hill between its junction with Elwell Street and Martinstown.
- [4] To impose temporary road closure on Monkton Road between its junction with A354 and its junction with the access road to Manor Farm.
- [5] To impose temporary road closure on Maiden Castle Road from its junction with Celtic Crescent to the Maiden Castle car park.
- [6] To impose temporary road closure on C53 between its junctions with Bats Lane and B3159
- [7] To impose temporary road closure on the west side of the triangle on Bats Lane at its junction of the C53
