Bursted Hill, Bishopsbourne

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2022

To allow drainage works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Bursted Hill, Bishopsbourne.

A closure is planned from 29th July 2022, with estimated completion by 29th July 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE40111307349-02 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One-Network

Bursted Hill will be closed from its junction with Pett Bottom Road, for a distance approximately 50 metres in a Westerly direction, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while drainage works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Pett Bottom Road, Broxhall Road, Hardres Court Road, Rectory Lane, Bursted Hill, and vice versa.
