- i) **Southern Water Treatment Plant:** Following discussions with Southern Water, Jonathan Elworthy reported that Southern water are now trying to put ownership of the Leylandii trees around the

treatment works onto Egerton Parish Council. The Clerk has forwarded a letter to Jonathan from Southern water dated 4th December 2012 which states that Southern water will be responsible for the trees.
