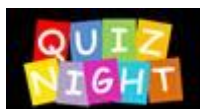

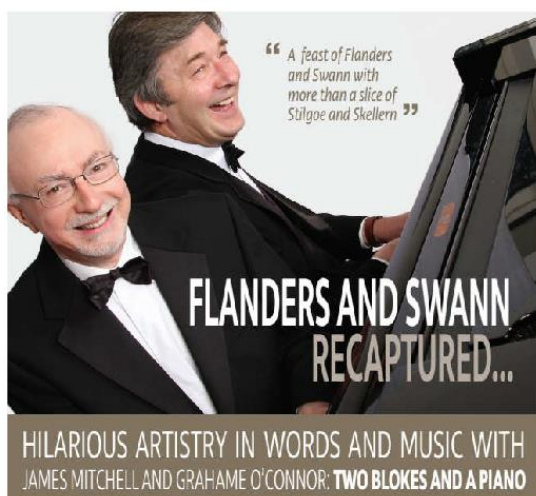
Café Church

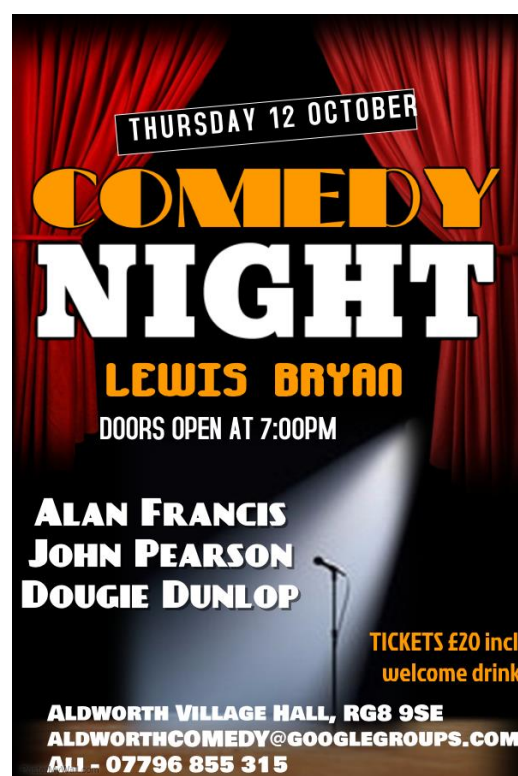
