Cllr. Kevin Salter commented that the volunteer working group were working hard to move the NHP forward and named a resident in particular who he said, was the driving force. Members thanked the resident and the other volunteers from the working group. Cllr. Kevin Sallter will be the Council's representative leading the group, he outlined the proposal in 3 phases, the 1st phase would cover setting up, appointing a consultancy & printing costs for leaflets. Council agreed that an amount of up to £5,000 has been earmarked for the NHP and confirmed that £1,000 would be available now to cover phase 1 costs. These monies will be held by the parish council and funds will be issued as required with the appropriate invoices. The NHP Forum will apply for grant funding to cover Phase 1 & 2, the form will be completed by volunteer members of the working group and signed by the Chairman of the council. Hall hire, website & wifi costs were discussed for future consideration.
