1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

2. DECLARATIONS OF INTERESTS OR LOBBYING

Members are invited to declare disclosable pecuniary interests and other interests in items on the agenda as required by the Newington Parish Council Code of Conduct for Members and by the Localism Act 2011.

(i) The nature as well as the existence of any such interest must be declared. After declaring a Disclosable Pecuniary Interest, the Member must leave the meeting and not take part in the discussion or vote. This applies even if there is provision for public speaking.

3. STAFFING MATTERS

Under the Public Bodies (Admission to Meetings) Act 1960, the public and representatives of the press and broadcast media be excluded from the meeting during the consideration of the following items of business as publicity would be prejudicial to the public interest because of the confidential nature of the business to be transacted.

- i. Arrangements for the management of legal proceedings
- ii. Use of a solicitor to oversee legal proceedings
- iii. Consideration of ACAS email
