(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2024

UK Power Networks works.

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Breach Lane, Upchurch.

A closure is planned from 13th May 2024, with estimated completion by 17th May 2024, or where stated on a valid Permit (KZ50067108587-03 - UK Power Networks). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

Breach Lane will be closed in the vicinity of Oast Cottages, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while utility works are undertaken by UK Power Networks.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A2 Hartlip Hill, London Road, Oak Lane, The Street, Forge Lane, Halstow Lane (Forge Lane), The Street (Forge Lane), Breach Lane and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
