#### 7) PLANNING MATTERS:

a) PA21/09282: Lanhydrock Farm Cottages – Alterations to two holiday units.

Following discussion, councillors agreed their unanimous support for the application.

b) Any planning applications received after publication of agenda: PA21/10255: Percy's House, Percy's Lane – Annexe change of use from office to residential

Following discussion, councillors agreed their unanimous support for the application.

# 8) PARISH MATTERS

a) Neighbourhood Plan: Following Bodmin Town Council's offer to create a unified Neighbourhood Plan with input from its surrounding parishes, councillors discussed the priorities they wished to be included. Cllr. J. Coad noted the parish's need for a central focal point whilst Cllr. Haywood raised her desire for better footpath links from the War Memorial Hall to Treffry/ Trebyan and for a children's play area. Cllr. A. Coad added that there is a need for affordable housing to allow young people to remain in the parish. It was noted that several of these features had been included on the rejected 2016 planning application PA16/08185 and that the planning application might make a good starting point for building Lanhydrock's Neighbourhood Plan.

**ACTION**: Cllr. J. Coad to contact applicant of PA16/08185 to enquire whether they intend to resubmit a revised version and, if so, to allow the parish council to review the details and consider whether they wish to support its inclusion in the Neighbourhood Plan.

b) The Queen's Platinum Jubilee: It was agreed that the parish council would donate £100 to the War Memorial Hall Committee for the procurement of commemorative mugs. Cllr. M Coad was also asked to make the committee aware of Andrew Williams offer to provide a commemorative tree for planting in the grounds, with councillors noting their preference for an oak.

**ACTION**: £100 to be donated to War Memorial Hall Committee for the procurement of commemorative Jubilee mugs and Cllr. M. Coad to report parish council's suggestion to plant a commemorative oak tree at the War Memorial Hall AGM in January.

c) Highways Update: The clerk reported that repairs to Newton Lane culvert had been pushed back to June 2022 due to the EA's refusal to grant their consent for CORMAC to work in the watercourse during salmonid spawning season. The clerk reported that the repairs to Respryn bridge were programmed for January 2022.
