ROAD CLOSURES 6th JUNE ONWARDS 8pm to 6am

We were advised this week by Surrey Highways that three local roads will soon be closed to allow major maintenance (resurfacing). We do not know the start or end dates for each closure, but we understand that the road works may begin on June 6th 2016, so look out for road signs with further information.

Meanwhile, In brief, the roads affected are:

a) Dorking Road (B2450), between its junctions with the Givons Grove Roundabout and Church Street (B2033).

Road to be closed in both directions between 8pm and 6am.

Vehicular traffic will be diverted via Church Road/Highlands Road/Reigate Road and By Pass Road (i.e. via Beaverbrook Roundabout).

b) A24 southbound between Givons Grove Roundabout and Swanworth Lane. Southbound carriageway to be closed between 8pm and 6am.

Vehicular traffic (southbound only) will be diverted via East Clandon (i.e. via A246 Young Street, Guildford Road, Leatherhead Road, Guildford Road, Epsom Road, A25 Shere Road, Station Road, Dorking Road, Guildford Road, Coast Hill, Guildford Road, Westcott Road, A2003 Station Road, Chalkpit Lane, Ashcombe Road, London Road and Mickleham By-Pass).

c) A24 between B2209 (Burford Bridge) and B2038 (Pixham Lane). Road to be closed in both directions between 8pm and 6am.

All vehicular traffic will be diverted via East Clandon (either clockwise or anticlockwise: via A24, Mickleham By-Pass/Dorking Road, A246 Young Street/Guildford Road/Leatherhead Road/Guildford Road/Epsom Road, A25 Shere Road/Station Road/Dorking Road/Guildford Road/Coast Hill/Guildford Road/Westcott Road, A2003 Station Road/Chalkpit Lane/Ashcombe Road).

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Surrey Highways advise that access will be maintained for pedestrians and emergency vehicles at all times. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses wherever reasonably possible and advanced notification will be given however in the event that it is necessary to restrict any access at any time under Section 3 of the Act, the road can only be closed for a maximum of 8 hours in any 24-hour period. Any vehicle found to be obstructing the highway during these works will be removed to a suitable location outside the limits of the works after all reasonable methods have been undertaken to identify and contact the vehicle's owner.
