- a) Are blocked drains to blame for recent flooding, have your say on proposed speed limit reductions and much more. Latest news from Dorset Council.
- b) Ground water flooding: Amber warning issued for Dorset. This was in place on 31st January.
- c) Sent on behalf of the NDA - NDA stakeholder survey - coming soon. The consultation starts on 9th February and will run for four weeks.
- d) Urgent Closure Of Grange Road Church Knowle. The works are expected to be completed by 03-02-2026.
- e) Dorset Council Town & Parish Council Forum - Planning and Building Control. Slides from the seminar.
- f) Fwd: Fw: News release - Dorset communities urged to prepare for groundwater flooding. The warning was for Thursday 5th February.
- g) NEWS: How is Dorset Council responding to flooding? Update from Cllr. Nick Ireland. Crews are currently out day and night, fixing urgent issues, and officers have been asked to look at bringing forward extra investment for places that flood repeatedly.

- k) DAPTC AGM - New Date Saturday 30 May 2026. This change has allowed Dorset Council additional time to take the draft Statement of Reasonable Expectations (SoRE) through its internal service areas and, importantly, through its governance and elected-member decision-making processes.
- l) BCP & Dorset Council Employment Land Study to Inform Local Plans. The final draft of the Local Plan consultation will be released in late March.
- m) Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Emergency Temporary Closure Of B3070, East Lulworth. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along B3070, EAST LULWORTH from junction with Povington Lane to a point approximately 90 metres to the west. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It came in to operation on 28 February 2026 and can remain in force for up to 21 days. This Notice will enable Dorset Council to carry out carriageway works due to a collapsed culvert.
