1. The Order

3. The 'Has Made' Notice (HM)

This is the public Notice we must advertise within 14 days of making an Order.

The proposed order comes into effect on the date shown. The date on the notices is when they will appear in the Eastern Daily Press. If we have to change any dates, we will let you know. NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (SWAFFHAM) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION ORDER 2018 ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984 SECTION 14(1)

ORDER restricting the use by vehicles and imposing a temporary suspension of the 8 parking bays at the London Street from its junction with Pit Lane for a distance of 20 metres southwards in the TOWN OF SWAFFHAM

- 1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order and whereas the Norfolk County Council as Traffic Authority for the Administrative County of Norfolk is satisfied that:-
 - (i) installation of a BT duct is required at the London Street from its junction with Pit Lane for a distance of 20 metres southwards in the TOWN OF SWAFFHAM (hereinafter referred to as the said road) and:
 - (ii) that in consequence a temporary suspension of the 8 parking bays be imposed and traffic over the said road will be temporarily prohibited to park, stop or load/unload on the said road with effect from 8th July 2019 to 12th July 2019 for the duration of the works expected to be about 5 days within the period.
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply:
 - (a) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or civil enforcement officer;
 - (b) to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which this Order applies.
- 3. The following Order will become suspended where they conflict with the provisions of this Order and during the operation of this Order as follows:-
 - The Norfolk County Council (Swaffham, Various Roads) (Street Parking Places) Order 2014.
- 4. This Order has a maximum duration of 18 months and will be revoked upon completion of the works. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Order the operational period of this Order may become extended to allow completion of the works after obtaining consent of the Secretary of State.

NOW THEREFORE the Norfolk County Council DO HEREBY ORDER, that with effect from 8th July 2019 to 12th July 2019 for the duration of the works the said road SHALL BE SUBJECT TO the temporary suspension of the 8 street parking places and SHALL BE RESTRICTED insofar as the parking or loading/unloading of vehicles will be PROHIBITED.




