# COUNCIL MEETING 14<sup>th</sup> JULY 2014 AT 7.30PM AT THE WROXETER HOTEL, WROXETER

PRESENT: Chairman –L. Davies (LD) P. Davies (PD), K. Pritchett. In attendance: Cllr. Wild (Shropshire Councillor), 2 members of the public

This meeting was inquorate and as such Council business could not be transacted.

As members of the public and Shropshire Council were present, the public session proceeded and this note records the issues raised. One member of the public expressed an interest in applying to become a Councillor. She was invited to apply and advised that applications would be considered at the September meeting.

## 1. CLLR. WILD'S REPORT

A local resident had complained about noise from The Wroxeter Hotel. A positive meeting had been held at the hotel to discuss this. It was felt that much of the noise was coming from the back windows of the hotel. The hotel owners are keen to address this and are getting acoustic blinds installed.

### 2. POLICE REPORT

There have been numerous burglaries in the area surrounding the parish, including repeat burglaries. There have been a large number of fuel thefts. In the parish, during May and June there were 7 road collisions, 1 dwelling burglary, 1 vehicle crime, 2 thefts, 1 ASB (nuisance) and 1 other crime.

#### 3. BUS SHELTERS

Cllr. Davies advised that people cutting the grass around Bluebell bus shelter with a strimmer are damaging the posts of the bus shelter. He suggested requesting that a weed killer be used.

#### 4. PLAY AREA

Cllr. Pritchett advised that he had read the ROSPA play area report and visited to look at the issues identified:

- Fence panel is leaning due to the hedge Clerk to find out if the grass contractor cuts the hedge
- Ramp needs repairing
- Some areas of wood need re-treating to stop them from being slippy. Cllr. Pritchett offered to do this.
- Post on toddler swing to be looked at again in November
