Role of LEAD

The **FIRST** to play or Lead, places the mat, delivers the jack and centres it before attempting to bowl as close as possible to the jack.

Role of Number 2

The **SECOND** plays after the lead and now has no further duties designated.

BOWLS in BRIEF



Role of Number 3

The **THIRD** may be called upon to play different types of shots in order to score more, or to place bowls tactically to protect an advantage. The third may also advise the skip on choice of shots, and agrees the number of shots scored, measuring if required. He should inform the SKIP of the result of every End.

BOWLS in BRIEF



Role of SKIP

The **SKIP** is in overall charge of the rink, directs the other players on choice of shots and tries to build the "head" of bowls to his or her advantage.
