- Around February time we had several reports from a resident of Whitebeam Drive of nuisance youth(s) kicking the front doors of resident's property in the nearby area. We were able to identify the youth(s) and through positive engagement with their parent this issue was immediately halted and so far there have been no further reports.
- We have been contacted by the manager of Russet Court about nuisance youths hanging around in the complex. We have conducted some patrols and so far, not seen any youth(s) and no recent reports have been made. Off the back of this we have been asked to talk to the residents and give them some safety advice around fraud and general safety awareness and this is planned for 19th May.
- On Saturday 11th April Harry and I conducted a drop in surgery at the Village Hall. This was advertised on My Community Voice and the Kent Police website. We brought along the Police engagement van and there was some positive engagement with local villagers.

Harry and I have had some positive contact with local businesses which we will try and continue to develop as well as being available to listen to any concerns or issues of local villagers. We also have several other Parishes to service so we will always try and seek to spread ourselves evenly across all of these. We are sometimes also called upon to backfill our response patrols when there is a shortage and so therefore sometimes our time is taken away by this.

At the Parish surgery on Saturday, it was mentioned that the village would like to see us patrolling the area when we can. We will always seek to do this when we can, whilst also sharing our time with other Parishes.
