

STAMPING



The new World Bowls stamp being engraved on to the bowl. All bowls should be tested every ten years, and the official stamp records the latest year when the bowls may be validly used.

What the marks mean on the official stamp.

17 - refers to the expiry of the stamp (in this instance 2017)

WB - stands for World Bowls

R - the official registration mark

P - indicates at which licensed test centre the bowl was stamped, in this case the letter P standing for Pershore Bowls Centre.

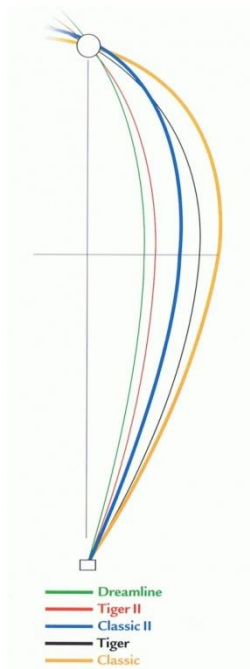

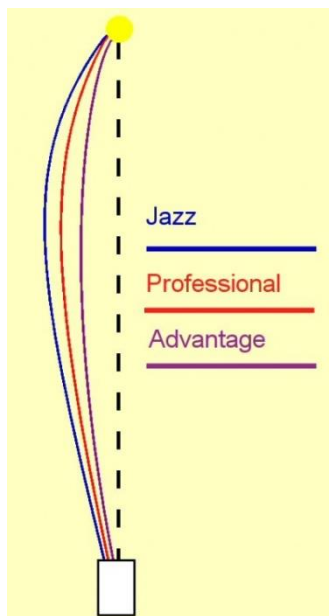

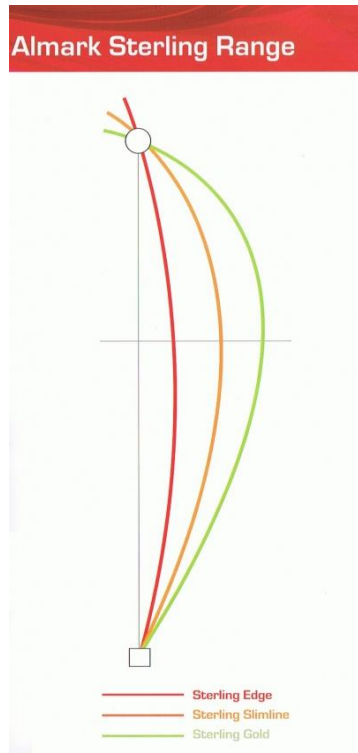
