**MANOR ROAD, ST NICHOLAS AT WADE,
BIRCHINGTON**

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new water supply, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Manor Road, St Nicholas at Wade, near Birchington.

A closure is currently planned from Wednesday 3 February 2021 with estimated completion by 5 February 2021.

Manor Road will be closed in the general vicinity of the property 'Detteken', with no through access between the junctions with Sandalwood Drive and Manor Lea Road.

The alternative route for through traffic is via A28 Canterbury Road and The Length.

Local access to the remainder of Manor Road continues from either direction.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation, and updated information can be found on www.one.network – [Southern Water Permit LQ001SWAT10875676], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
