Hi

I've noticed over the past few years that the border of the allotment access path, on the left as one walks down to the plots from Virgins Lane, has become dangerously subsided. This is particularly bad from the first plot on the right, (Plot 1 I believe) and continues down past our plot 3A.

There are also wide gaps towards the stream that runs parallel to the path, wide enough for someone to slip down into.

I am very concerned that the combination of subsidence and the gaps could cause a serious accident. The path also narrows considerably near our plot, adding to the hazard.
