## **HARDRES COURT ROAD, UPPER HARDRES**

### **TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING**

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

**Kent County Council gives notice that Hardres Court Road, Upper Hardres will be closed to through traffic, on or after 13th June 2023 for up to 4 days.**

**The road will be closed near to the junction with Bursted Hill.**

**The alternative route is via Hardres Court Road, The Street, Bossingham Road, Minnis Lane, Curtis Lane, Stone Street and Faussett Hill.**

**Access for buses to be maintained at all times.**

**This closure is necessary to enable drainage repairs to be carried out by Kent County Council.**

**This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.**
