SUNKEN TRAMPOLINE – CURRENT FINANCIAL POSITION

DH informed the committee that 3 grants have been secured, each from the WDDC:

S-106 £1,433.25

WDDC chairman ££500

WDDC Leisure Development Fund £1,000

A further grant from the National Lottery for £1.380 is pending.

A gift of £1,000 has been received from a donor who wishes to remain anonymous.

Cash in the Playing Field Restoration Fund £1,143.33

5. SUNKEN TRAMPOLINE – SITUATION
The order for the trampoline was placed with Huck Nets on 13th September. The trampoline should arrive at the Huck Nets Bridport Depot on 18th October 2018. Huck Nets will deliver it to the Puncknowle playing field on a date yet to be agreed. To make room for the trampoline the drop rope traverse has been moved. This was done by Geoff Fry, Nigel Arak-Newman and Derek Heaver. Pete Tewson will no longer be required to dig the trampoline excavation hole. Nigel Arak-Newman and Derek Heaver will dig this by hand on 22nd September. The opening for and first use of the sunken trampoline is planned for 11th November 2018. This is to coincide with the anniversary of the ending of the 1914-18 First World War. A plaque dedicating the trampoline to the memory of the dead of that war is to be placed by the trampoline stating that they gave their lives that we might ‘.....live, work and play in freedom’.
6. FAMILY BINGO, 29th JUNE 2018
This was very successful and raised over £500 toward the sunken trampoline.
