








Vicarage Note

Easter: A Season of Joy and New Beginnings

Every year, as spring begins to awaken the world around us, we celebrate Easter. Gardens start to bloom, the days grow brighter, and there is a sense that life is beginning again. For Christians, this season of renewal beautifully reflects the true meaning of Easter: the resurrection of Jesus Christ and the hope it brings to the world.

Easter is the heart of the Christian faith. It is the joyful celebration that Jesus, who was crucified on Good Friday, rose from the dead on Easter morning. What seemed like the end of the story was, in fact, a glorious new beginning. Through his death and resurrection, Jesus showed us the depth of God's love and opened the way for forgiveness, hope, and eternal life.

The events of Easter remind us that love is stronger than hatred, light is stronger than darkness, and life is stronger than death. Jesus willingly gave his life for us, taking upon himself the weight of human sin and suffering. Yet the story does not end at the cross. On the third day, the tomb was found empty, and Christ was alive. The resurrection is God's powerful promise that death does not have the final word.


For Christians, this means that no situation is beyond hope. Easter tells us that God can bring new life out of the most difficult circumstances. Just as spring follows winter, God's grace brings renewal where we least expect it. The risen Christ meets us in our ordinary lives, offering forgiveness, peace, and the chance to begin again.

This is why Easter is such a joyful celebration. Churches ring with music and song, candles shine brightly, and the ancient greeting is shared: "Christ is risen!" – "He is risen indeed!" These words are not simply part of tradition; they are a declaration of hope that has echoed through the centuries.

Easter also invites us to live as people of the resurrection. If Christ has brought new life to the world, then we are called to share that life with others: through kindness, compassion, forgiveness, and love. Small acts of care and generosity become signs of the new life that Easter proclaims.

The Gathering Shipton Reading Room




Come to prepare for the week ahead with a service for praise with quiet contemplation



A number of the well-thumbed books previously on the shelves have been moved on, and there are now a number of “new” books on the shelves for you all to have a look at, and borrow if you wish.


Books and puzzles are now date stamped before being put on display to try to enable the volunteers to keep refreshing the stock, and ensure a ready “new” supply.

Andoversford Parish Council



Traffic speeds and road safety were key topics at the most recent Parish Council meeting, and Councillors discussed with the members of the public who attended, a range of measures aimed at reducing speeds and improving traffic conditions through the village.

Following a recent on-site meeting with Gloucestershire Highways, County Councillor Paul Hodgkinson has agreed to allocate some existing funding to support the Parish Council's plans to improve road safety.

The proposals include installing village gates at the three main entrances to the village, as well as installing speed cameras along Gloucester Road. These measures are designed to clearly indicate to drivers that they are entering the village and should reduce their speed.

As with all installations on the roadside, the plans must first receive approval from Gloucestershire Highways. The Parish Council is currently awaiting further details and confirmation, but hopes that work can begin in the near future.

A traffic mirror will be installed to help drivers see more clearly when turning into Pine Halt.



Elsewhere in the village, a new litter bin has recently been installed near the Village Hall to help keep the area tidy. The Parish Council also confirmed it will once again support the Village Hall's popular Summer Fun Day, a community event that brings residents together each year and is open to everyone.




Cobalt Medical Charity Update




There is lots happening over the coming months in support of Cobalt Medical Charity, and everyone is warmly invited to take part.

Starting from Linton House and finishing at The Exmouth Arms on Bath Road, the walk offers two gentle routes of around 5–7 km, suitable for all ages and abilities. Walkers can start anytime from 10am, and maps will be provided in advance. It's a relaxed and friendly way to enjoy the outdoors while raising funds for a good cause.

April brings Make a Will Month, when participating solicitors will write a will free of charge in return for a donation to Cobalt. Places are limited each year, so early booking is recommended.

Garden lovers are in for a treat with two special open garden events.

In April, visitors can enjoy the Rare Plant Sale and Open Garden at Quenington, and in June the beautiful gardens at Highnam Court will open in support of the charity, with plant stalls, refreshments, and plenty to explore.



On 23 April there will also be a free talk at Linton House, where Cobalt's medical team will explain how the charity has been supporting patients across Gloucestershire, Herefordshire and Worcestershire for over 60 years.
