### The Management Committee News

Work to restore ball-stop netting is taking slightly longer to complete than originally anticipated. Assessments have been made and although the risk of a ball being struck over the boundary is deemed low, it is a foreseeable risk the Management Committee is addressing. The first fixture (Shifnal CC v Wem CC) is scheduled for Sunday 27th April at 1pm, with fixtures between May & September published on the Shifnal CC website <a href="https://shifnalcc.co.uk/pages/match-centre">https://shifnalcc.co.uk/pages/match-centre</a>. As a temporary solution, we would be grateful for any help possible from members / volunteers, in sourcing a suitable access platform from which to re-secure the netting to the poles. Please contact a member of the Management Committee if you are able to help and form a small working-party.

Maintenance tasks around the bowling green are varied with the focus during Q2 & Q3 this year, including the levelling of paving slabs and repainting of the ramp to the clubhouse. Whilst we await delivery of warning signage, please take extra care when transiting the footpaths

and stepping up & down the step at the front of the clubhouse. With the uncertain weather it has been challenging for the "green team" to get continuing treatments applied to the green. Please look out for notices of temporary closures and advice for hand-washing after it has been treated.

<u>The Level 1 Coaching</u> course details for the course being organised for Mid Shropshire's drive to get a coach per club are below. There is due to be a level 1 coaches' course based Online & at **Shifnal**. If we want to expand our Juniors or Adults we need a coach, an interested club member who can give time to helping others into the game. If you've enjoyed our game and want to give something back this is your chance.

The course costs £150 payable on booking (maybe the club could help with the initial cost?). There is help with costs following successful completion of the qualification: 50% BGBCA subsidy (£75), £30 from SCGBA. £19 of the remainder is the first of the coach's annual personal membership of Coach Bowls and insurance. This is the most local course ever for us. ## **Competitions**

Paul is planning a different style of competition this season – <u>The Accumulator</u>. Starting on Sunday, <u>11 May</u> 11 am, this will be a <u>monthly</u> competition for all levels of players. It will be handicapped so that broadly Division 1 players will begin on scratch, Division 2 players will start with 2 points, Division 3 players on 3 points and Division 4 & 5 and social bowlers on 4 points. Paul will designate a handicap to any who play on Thursday and Saturday who do not play in any other league and the ladies. Paul's decision on this will be final. Entrants each month will be drawn into groups of 4 and play each of the other members of the group in a round robin, starting with their handicap points on the cards and play to the first to 13 points each time.
