- a) Dorset Council Planning and Building Control Town and Parish Council Virtual Forum. The in-person event is taking place on Tuesday 8 September from 10am-12.30pm at the Corn Exchange, Dorchester
- b) Dorset Council Parking. DAPTC held briefing sessions on parking review listening events starting 28th July. The formal consultation will start in November.
- c) Hot weather advice; behind the scenes at Dorset History Centre; and much more. Dorset have joined Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole (BCP), Somerset and Wiltshire councils in expressing interest in forming a Mayoral Strategic Authority for Wessex.
- d) Wessex Water update – hosepipe ban introduced. From Tuesday 18 August at 00:01hrs 1.4 million customers – in areas including Dorset – must not use a hosepipe for activities such as watering gardens, washing cars, patios, paths and driveways, cleaning windows or filling swimming and paddling pools.
- e) Introducing your new look Dorset Connect: Swanage network meetings. The next meeting will be on Monday 30th November from 13:00 to 15:30 at Herston Village Hall.
- f) e-News 25 August 2026. Local Government Services Pay Agreement 2026/27. The agreed pay award for the current year which is backdated and effective from 1 April 2026. Pay rates will be increased by 3.3%.
