Lime Kiln Lane, Bossingham

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER AUGUST 2022

To allow utility cover repair works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Lime Kiln Lane, Bossingham.

A closure is planned from 29th August 2022, with estimated completion by 1st September 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB00632781273-03 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

Lime Kiln Lane will be closed outside Little Bossingham Farm, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while utility cover repair works are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Lime Kiln Lane, B2068 Stone Street, Curtis Lane, Minnis Lane, Bossingham Road, The Street and vice versa.
