Community Area Transport Group (CATG).

8th February 2017

Meeting held at the Nadder Centre, Tisbury.

Attendees were asked to support the northern route for the proposed A303 tunnel.

Parishes were asked to contribute £50 to the Save Our Beds campaign (Westminster Hospital, Shaftesbury). I asked what power could be used and informed to worry about that later.

The four 20mph limits are now installed – Tisbury, Broadchalke, Fovant and Quidhampton.

Next tranche of 20mph bids.

- Only 2 per annum.
- Parishes need to make a case, last year each parish was given a 3-5 min slot.
- Parish is expected to fund construction and finance.
- CATG will pay the legal costs
- Assessment costs £2500 per scheme, the parish is expected to pay £1000 towards the assessment.

For info the 20mph in Fovant and Quidhampton cost £3000 and £7000 respectively, the cost depends on size of area covered and number of signs / roundels required.

White lines

CATG have a list of lines requiring repainting. Cand G tarmac are an approved contractor and plan to start work once the roads dry out.

Road maintenance

- There is a list (for highway officers only) that lists the top 15 sites for maintenance in South and East Wiltshire.
- Luke St is on the long list but not on the Top 15 list.
- Local highway officers do not collate the list this is done higher up the chain.

Freight Assessment

- Last year SWWAB CATG put forward Tollard Royal and B3089 at Dinton. Tollard Royal was taken forward by WC and an assessment will take place late Feb / early March.
- CATG was able to submit two more sites.

It was agreed to submit

- B3089 Dinton
- C320 Stratford Tony

A30 Brook Hill at Donhead St Andrew will be put forward as a substantive bid.
