

# Valentina Seferinova

Pianist Valentina Seferinova was born in Vidin, on the River Danube in Bulgaria. Recognised as a child prodigy, she gave solo recitals and played with many different chamber ensembles and symphony orchestras (both as soloist and accompanist) from a very early age.



To her natural talent she added an internationally recognised Master of Music (Theory) degree; together with an Assistant Prof. of Music (Performance).

She has played, by invitation, at some of the most prestigious private and public venues across Europe.

Now award winning pianist Valentina Seferinova has a highly successful international career. She has played at all the worlds greatest venues, recorded many albums and performs frequently for radio and television. Valentina plays both as a soloist and in theatrical productions world wide. Valentina is well known on Hayling Island for performing as a soloist with Havant Symphony Orchestra.

Her issued CD list is now 11 – with a 12th CD recording contract just agreed for some Concertante pieces under the baton of American Grammy Award winning conductor John McLaughlin Williams.

Holding dual Bulgarian-British nationality, Valentina combines a lectureship at Havant & South Downs College; teaching at Churcher's College in Petersfield; and a busy schedule of concerts, recitals, and recordings in the United Kingdom and abroad; and raising her family with her British husband.
