JOB DESCRIPTION:

To deburr and finish machined components using various hand held tools and finishing materials. Ensure components are finished to the standard expected by the customer within given deadlines. Liaise with the line manager and other departments to manage workload and customer requirements. Read and understand technical drawings to ensure components are in line with job requirements.

- To identify damage to a component by completing detailed visual checks on machined metal not previously noticed by the operators
- Know when a component should be rejected and return to operator
- To deburr the component and finish it to a high standard using RET marked up drawings
- To undertake chemical cleaning when needed
- Accurately understand RET internal drawings
- Complete and update job sheets accurately
- Despatch parts to sub-contractors
- Communicate effectively with the Operators
- Work with minimum supervision within a team environment
- Maintain a high level of tidiness and order at all times around your work area, in the workshops and around machines
